



ETRC 1st Spring Club Trial Daryl and Sharon Miller Farm <u>Saturday, March 30</u> Sweetwater, TN

ETRC will hold the first Spring Club Trial at the Daryl and Sharon Miller Farm, 5249 Holt Road, Sweetwater, TN. ETRC thanks the Millers for allowing the club to use their beautiful farm. The farm is located next to the Holt Farm that ETRC used for AKC Hunt Tests and training until 2006. The Miller's have a right-of-way across the Holt Farm to access their farm. Please do not stop on the Holt Farm but continue through to the back ponds and the barn. Arrow signs will be posted from the Interstate 75. <u>DRIVING DIRECTIONS: Take I-75 South to Sweetwater Exit 62 onto Hwy 322. Go west 1.7 miles to County Road 200 and turn right. Go 1/2 mile past Holt Tractor Sales building to 5249 Holt Road. Turn right and go 3/4 mile to barn.</u>

Starting time will be 8 AM. Events will include Singles Classic, Master, Senior, Junior, Advanced Junior, and Puppy Stakes. To enter sign up at the barn at \$10.00 for each event except puppies are \$5.00. Puppies Stakes are classified as one year and under. Unfrozen ducks will be thrown or bumpers for puppies. No e-collars allowed. Hired birdboys will be used. Members earn points toward the Gun Dog of the Year and Puppy of the Year annual awards. Beginners are welcome to participate or watch. Bring your retriever, a chair, your lunch, and water. All dogs must be on leash when out of vehicle or except running in a test.
